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## 2011 HALLOWEEN PARADE

October 22, 2011 (Rain Date: Oct. 23)

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Assembly for all floats, bands and marchers will begin at 4:00 pm on the upper level of Memorial Park at the corner of DePew and Piermont Avenues. Individual marchers may register on the day of the parade. The parade will step off at 5:30 pm. Marchers will proceed south on Piermont Avenue, west onto Cedar Hill Avenue, north on Broadway to Main Street, west on Main Street to Franklin, and south on Franklin to Artopee Way. The parade will end at our Halloween Bandstand in the Municipal Parking Lot at Riverspace.

Main Street will remain closed from Franklin Street to Broadway until 8 p.m., to allow for live music, award ceremonies and additional activities at the Bandstand. The best vantage points for spectators will be along Main Street and South Broadway.

### RULES & REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS

**(1) All floats** must be registered with the Chamber of Commerce of the Nyacks by October 14, 2010.

**(2) Floats / vehicles** must not exceed 13 feet in height. Tractor-trailers are prohibited.

**(3) Insurance:**

(a) Organizations entering a float or operating a motor vehicle must provide the Village of Nyack with a certificate of insurance showing not less than \$1,000,000 liability coverage and naming the Village of Nyack and Chamber of Commerce of the Nyacks as additional insureds.

(b) Individuals desiring to enter a float (unaffiliated with an organization) are required to pre-register and provide an insurance certificate for the coverage indicated above.

(c) Individuals who have difficulty meeting these insurance requirements should contact the Chamber office.

**(4) All vehicles and floats** must be escorted by a minimum of four individuals. These persons should walk on the street at each corner of the vehicle to act as safety monitors to protect the public.

**(5) Throwing of candy, toys or other objects from vehicles or floats is strictly prohibited**, as this creates potential for serious personal injury. Anyone observed violating this rule will be subject to police action and will not be eligible for participation in future events. Participants on foot may distribute candy to spectators, but are urged not to create a situation where spectators are encouraged to enter the parade route and expose themselves to the danger of moving vehicles.

**(6) The sale of "Silly String"** or similar items and the spraying of same by parade participants or spectators will not be permitted. This material creates a litter problem, encourages spectators to leave the sidewalk and poses grave safety risks. In addition, clean up of this material is expensive and difficult.

It is the opinion of the Chamber of Commerce of the Nyacks that the above comments and requirements are reasonable and necessary to continue the tradition of Nyack's Halloween Parade as the premier event of its kind in the Tri-state area.
